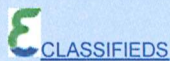

Notice to boat storage holders

If you rent boat racks, beach space or other storage areas, make sure your watercraft are stored in the appropriate places.

If you have not paid your annual fee for your space(s), please remove your property immediately. Watercraft will be taken away at the end of the month so people on our waiting lists can use the spaces. There is a fee to recover your boats.

Also, please lock your boats to the storage area if possible and do not leave paddles, life jackets or other items with your boat. Items have been stolen and vandalized, and boats have been "borrowed" when not locked up.
